No Cost Tips

These simple steps don't cost a thing, but can potentially save you 10-25 percent on your monthly energy bill.

- Turn off lights and appliances when not in use. Don't forget your computer. Most new computers have "sleep" settings.
- In warm months, set the thermostat to 78-80 degrees when home and five to 10 degrees warmer at night or when you're not home.
- In the cooling season, close blinds and drapes during the day to keep heat out.
- Also, use your dishwasher, clothes washer and dryer, and cook as late in the evening as possible.
- Barbecue outdoors when practical, keeping in mind the heat and effect of sun on your body. Reducing the heat inside your home from any source, such as cooking, will reduce the load on your air conditioning.
- Use pool trippers to reduce the time your swimming pool pump runs—eight to 12 hours a day is plenty.
