

Carson City Undergrounding Surcharge: Effective January 1, 2011 as ordered in docket 10-06001; all residential and commercial Customers in Carson City will pay a surcharge of \$0.00081 per KWH for a period of 36 months. This surcharge is listed as a separate line item on Carson City bills, "Carson City Undergrounding Surchg." The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada has ordered NV Energy to collect this charge in order to recover incremental costs to place certain electric lines in Carson City underground, as required by the Carson City Board of Supervisors.

Minimum Charge: The minimum charge for service is the Basic Service Charge.

When the turn-on, meter set or change of account involves a combination of gas and electric service which is accomplished at the same time for all services, NV Energy will apply a single service establishment charge for all services.

**Sierra Pacific Power d/b/a NV Energy Electric Rate Schedules for Residential Customers**

The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) recently authorized changes to certain components of electric rates, which has resulted in an increase in the total rate. These changes became effective on **January 1, 2012**. See the next page for actual rates.

NV Energy's rates shown here are in addition to any Local Government Fee based upon revenue or quantity of energy sold. These taxes are imposed upon the utility by the local governments within our service territory.

In addition, the customer will also be billed for the Universal Energy Charge of \$0.00039 per kWh of usage with monies going to the State of Nevada fund for energy assistance and conservation as set forth in NRS 702.010 to 702.282.

The rates contained in this schedule are for bundled rates. Bundled rates are the combination of all the services necessary (generation, transmission and distribution) to deliver reliable electric power to retail end-use customers. Distribution Only Service is available to certain eligible customers who meet the provisions set forth in chapter 704B of the Nevada Administrative Code.

**HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR BILL**

For a Domestic Service customer on a 30-day billing period (27-34 days is the typical range of billing days), 5 percent Local Government Fee and 745 kWh usage during the billing cycle:

c. Deferred Energy Accounting Adjustment, 745 kWh x \$(0.01565) kWh \$ (11.66)
d. Temp. Green Power Financing (TRED): 745 kWh x \$0.00142/kWh \$ 1.06
e. Renewable Energy Program (REPR): 745 kWh x \$0.00595/kWh \$ 4.43
f. Energy Efficiency Charge(EE): 745 kWh x \$0.00298/kWh \$ 2.22

**ADDITIONAL CHARGES**

Universal Energy Charge: \$0.00039 per all kWh of usage. Monies go to the State of Nevada fund for energy assistance and conservation as set forth in NRS 702.010 to 702.282.

Late Charge: 1 percent of any amount in arrears from the previous billing.

Local Government Fee: A tax of variable amount as imposed by any political subdivision such as business license fees, gross receipts tax or other similar tax. The Local Government Fee is calculated by multiplying the percent of the fee (Washoe County currently is 5 percent) times the total bill prior to the Local Government Fee minus the Universal Energy Charge and Washoe County Undergrounding Surcharge (for Washoe County residents only).

Washoe County Undergrounding Surcharge: Effective January 1, 2011 as ordered in docket 10-06001; all residential and commercial Customers in Washoe County will pay a surcharge of \$0.00159 per KWH. This surcharge is listed as a separate line item on Washoe County customers' bills as, "Washoe Co. Undergrounding Surcharge." The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada has ordered NV Energy to collect this charge in order to recover incremental costs to place certain electric transmission lines in Washoe County underground, as required by the Washoe County Board of Commissioners.
