Please read items 1-5 prior to continuing application.

1. TDRs processed by NV Energy they are done on a first-come, first-serve basis. The typical TDR is worked 2 to 6 weeks after all the needed information is received.
2. For a typical TDR the NV Energy crews will arrive between 7:00am and 8:00am to disconnect the service. Someone must be present on-site at the time of arrival or the service will not be disconnected. The crew will return between 1:00 pm and 2:00pm to reconnect. Please be aware that you will need to have your final electrical inspection by the appropriate government agency before the crew returning to reconnect. If you are unable to get your final inspection before the crew arrives it can take up to two (2) working days to get you rescheduled for reconnect.
3. Please complete this application in FULL as NV Energy will not process any incomplete requests. Once you have completed this application, submit to the NV Energy New Development Center located at 7155 Lindell Road, Las Vegas, NV 89118 or via fax at (702)402-0871. If you are not familiar with this process or if you have additional questions, please contact the NV Energy New Development Center by phone at (702) 402-8400 (option 2).
4. If the the panel is being upgraded the existing facilities may not be adequate to accommodate your request. If this is the case you will be required to fill out a Project Information Sheet and submit to the New Development Center or fax to (702)402-0871. For more information please call (702)402-8400 (option 2).
5. All the work being done by the customer must be disclosed at the time of this request to the NV Energy New Development Center. If upon arrival, the NV Energy crew determines the conditions are not the same as the request, the work will not be completed, and you must resubmit.

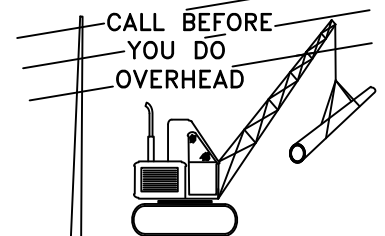
