

Sierra Pacific Power d/b/a NV Energy Quarterly Natural Gas/Propane Base Tariff and Deferred Energy Accounting Adjustment

Effective **January 1, 2012**, Sierra Pacific Power Company d/b/a NV Energy is adjusting its Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) and Deferred Energy Accounting Adjustment (DEAA) to reflect decreases in natural gas costs the company pays on behalf of its customers. These changes will result in a revenue decrease of \$4,005,374. Increases or decreases are passed on dollar-for-dollar, with no profit to the company.

The company makes quarterly BTER and DEAA filings on November 15, February 15, May 15, and August 15. These adjustments become effective 45 days from the date of filing. The transactions and recorded costs of natural gas which are the basis for any quarterly rate adjustment will be reviewed for reasonableness and prudence in the next proceeding held by the Commission to review the annual rate adjustment application.
