This BTER/DEAA decrease is attributable to costs the utility pays to purchase electricity from external suppliers or to purchase fuel to generate electricity for customers.

The chart on the reverse side reflects the adjustment for the average monthly bill for each customer class. Actual changes to individual customers' bills will vary depending on the level of consumption.



Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy Quarterly Electric Base Tariff and Deferred Energy Accounting Adjustment

Effective **July 1, 2012**, Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy is adjusting its Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) and Deferred Energy Accounting Adjustment (DEAA) to reflect changes in energy or purchased power costs the company pays on behalf of its customers. This change will result in a revenue decrease of \$38,458,859.

The company makes quarterly filings on May 15, August 15, November 15, and February 15. These adjustments become effective 45 days from the date of filing. The transactions and recorded costs of purchased fuel or purchased power which are the basis for any quarterly rate adjustment will be reviewed for reasonableness and prudence in the next proceeding held by the Commission to review the annual deferred energy accounting adjustment application.
