Best Data: Most Accurate Estimate

Copy of all pages of electric and/or gas bills from comparable location.

Second Best Data

Electric: Peak demand winter and summer (including period covered), hours of operation, kilowatt hours and load factor.

Gas: Therms by month

Minimum Data: Least Accurate Estimate

Electric: Peak demand or kilowatt hours (including period covered)

Gas: Therms
