APPLICABLE

This schedule is applicable to all service where demand is less than fifty (50) kW and monthly energy consumption is less than 10,000 kWh, and where another schedule is not specifically applicable. By Customer request, this schedule is applicable to community ballparks where such service is solely or primarily for outdoor lighting service and is subject to approval by the Utility. This General Service schedule includes technologies on the customer's side of the electricity meter, including, without limitation, energy production, energy savings, energy consumption, energy storage or energy shifting technologies, provided that such technologies do not compromise the safety and reliability of the utility grid.

Entire Nevada Service Area, as specified.

<u>RATES</u>

The charges applicable to this rate schedule are set forth in the currently effective Statement of Rates and are incorporated herein by reference. Rates can be found beginning on PUCN Sheet No. 63G. Distribution-only rates can be found beginning on PUCN Sheet No. 63M.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum charge for service hereunder shall be the Basic Service Charge and the Additional Meter Charge.

LATE CHARGE

The Utility may charge a fee as set forth in Schedule MC for the late payment of a bill.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. <u>UEC.</u> The Universal Energy Charge (UEC), pursuant to NAC 702.150 through 702.450, will go to fund the Nevada fund for energy assistance and conservation. Under certain circumstances, Customers will be refunded amounts paid in excess of \$25,000 per calendar quarter. The Commission will administer the collection of the UEC, certify exemptions, and administer refunds. Exemptions are generally kWh sold to:
 - a) Any governmental agency, including the State of Nevada and any political subdivision thereof, and
 - b) Any Customer using electrolytic-manufacturing processes.

Except as provided above, all kWh sold are subject to the charge. The UEC is not subject to the charges applicable under the Tax Adjustment Charge. (Continued)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

- 2. <u>Combination of Meter Readings.</u> Except for separately metered water heating, meter readings shall not be combined for billing hereunder.
- 3. <u>Separately Metered Water Heating.</u> Consumption for separately metered water heating shall be billed in combination with other service provided hereunder. No additional minimum charge shall be made when reading(s) are so combined.
- 4. <u>**Distribution Voltage.</u>** Service hereunder shall be supplied at one standard distribution voltage.</u>
- 5. <u>Contract for Service.</u> Utility may require a contract for service hereunder for a minimum term of not less than one year.
- 6. **<u>Rate Schedule Assignments.</u>** Rate schedules shall be assigned monthly by Utility, based on the demand and kWh levels contained in the various applicability sections.
- 7. **Unmetered Service**. Unmetered services installed prior to January 1, 2014, and billed under this schedule using an established monthly energy use for the service, are grandfathered. Unmetered service after January 1, 2014 under this schedule is prohibited, and is closed to new unmetered installations. Utility may install testing equipment to verify the consumption of the devices, and adjust the consumption amount billed based on the results of the tests. If testing indicates that the usage varies significantly, the Utility may require the installation of a meter. Customers with unmetered service and billing hereunder may request to convert to metered service and billing; however, customer shall bear all costs of such conversion other than those costs that are the responsibility of the Utility under Rule No. 16.

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
