RATES

Monthly billings shall equal the sum of the following charges:

Basic Service Charge

Per Installation Per Month \$ 11.65

Facilities Charge

Per Month (determined individually for each customer):

1.5% of the total amount invested by Sierra Pacific to provide service hereunder.

Late Charge

1% on any amount in arrears from previous billings.

Tax Adjustment Charge

2% of total bill within incorporated area (3/4 of 1% for City of Gabbs) or as designated in specific franchise or business license agreements.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum charge for service hereunder shall be the sum of the Basic Service Charge, facilities charge, late charge, and tax adjustment. (T)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Subject to any requested review made to the Commission or a court of competent jurisdiction by the Commission Staff, Office of the Consumer Advocate or a potential participant in the program, the Utility shall retain the right to determine eligibility under this tariff. The Utility shall also be responsible for the design of facilities to provide service under this tariff. Facilities installed to provide service under this tariff shall be owned, operated, and maintained by Utility. The total investment by Utility to provide a single service under this tariff shall not exceed \$50,000.
2. If a generator is provided for back-up support of facilities under this tariff, fuel for the generator will be provided by the Customer, at his expense.
3. Utility shall require a contract for service hereunder for all customers in this class. The minimum term for the contract shall be fifteen (15) years.
