



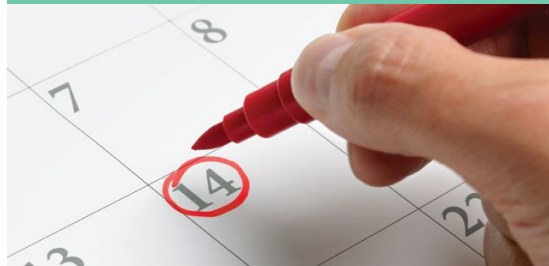
Attention Southern Nevada Seniors

Springtime Safety

If you're considering any projects to spruce up your home or other areas this spring, remember to always make safety your first priority. Following are good starting points when doing any type of job that requires digging or overhead work:

Call Before You Dig: The law requires you or your contractor to call 811 before digging in order to prevent damage to underground utility pipes and lines, and to prevent possible injury.

Call Before You Crane: Before doing any work that puts you at risk of coming into contact with overhead lines, the law requires you to call (702) 402-2929. Additionally, we offer tree trimming services for branches that could come into contact with high voltage lines. Visit nvenergy.com/tree to learn more.
