- We are well on our way to achieving the state's renewable portfolio standard of 50 percent by 2030.
- Four new solar projects are on track to be completed in Nevada this year, which will provide enough energy to power 170,000 homes at once.
- We've received approval from the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) for two additional solar plus battery storage projects to be built in Valmy, Nevada and ultimately replace the Valmy Generating Station, our only remaining coal-fired power plant.
- We are moving forward on our Greenlink Nevada transmission initiative that will connect our state and transform Nevada's clean energy landscape by unlocking renewable energy zones throughout western and northern Nevada, improving system resiliency and reliability, and driving the creation of thousands of jobs and hundreds of millions of dollars in investment into our Nevada communities.
