The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) has scheduled Consumer Sessions and Evidentiary Hearings for Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy and Sierra Pacific Power Company d/b/a NV Energy (together “the Companies”) for approval of the cost recovery of the regulatory assets relating to the development and implementation of the 2023 Joint Natural Disaster Protection Plan (“NDPP”).

PROPOSED RATE CHANGE

On March 1, 2024, the Companies made their annual NDPP regulatory asset filing with the PUCN. The filing seeks recovery of the 2023 NDPP regulatory asset account and the authority to reset NDPP rates.

The effect of granting this application will be to increase overall revenue of Nevada Power Company by \$29,964,239 or 1.02% across all rate classes and to increase overall revenue of Sierra Pacific Power Company by \$16,094,509 or 1.52% across all rate classes.

Ultimately, the PUCN may set rates that are higher or lower than those requested by the Companies.
