

## CONSUMER SESSION AND HEARING NOTICE

The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) has scheduled a Consumer Session and Evidentiary Hearings for Sierra Pacific Power Company d/b/a NV Energy for approval to implement the new Schedule No. NMR-2025, Net Metering Rider-2025, and to close Schedule NMR-405, Net Metering Rider-405, to new customers. This filing was designated as Commission Docket 25-03006. If approved by the PUCN, current NEM customers will not be impacted by the proposed tariff. NMR-2025 will only apply to customers who add solar after the tariff is approved.
