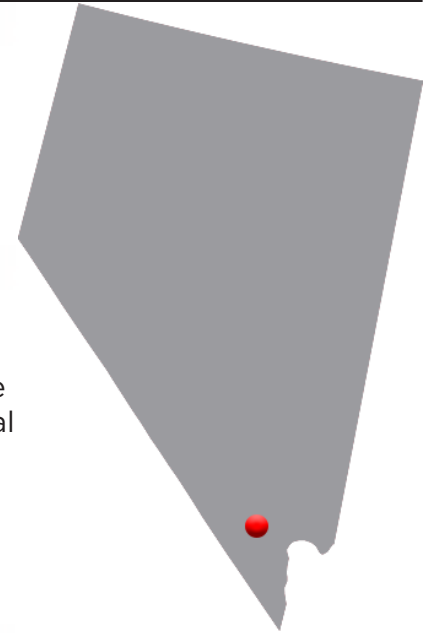


TAXES
