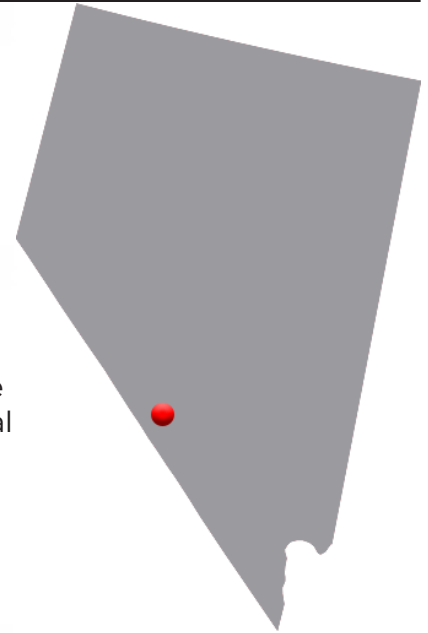


TAXES
