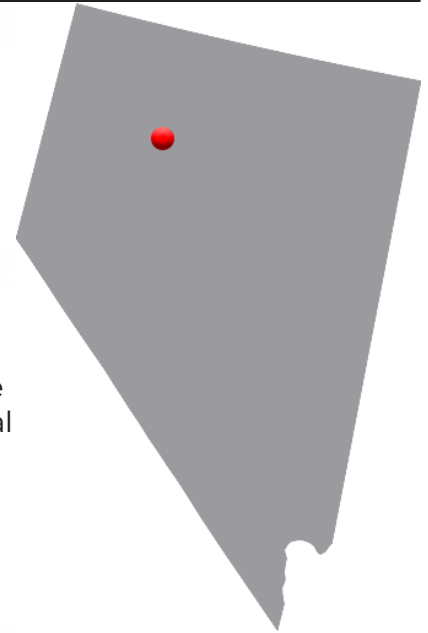


## TAXES
