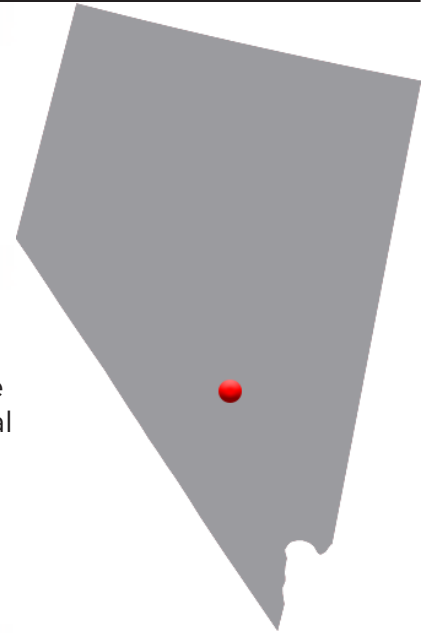
## INCENTIVES
