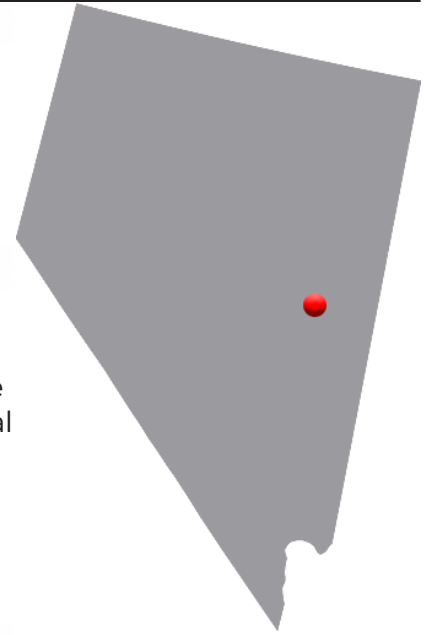


## TAXES
