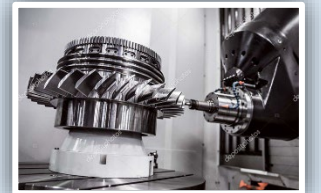

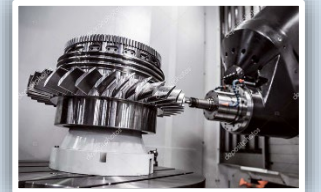

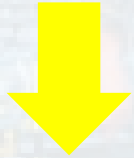

## **TAX ABATEMENTS**

**Sales and Use Tax Abatement** - Sales and use tax abatement on qualified capital equipment purchases, with reductions in the rate to as low as 2%.

**Modified Business Tax Abatement** - An abatement of 50 percent of the 1.17% rate on quarterly wages exceeding \$50,000.

**Personal Property Tax Abatement** - An abatement on personal property not to exceed 50% over a maximum of 10 years.

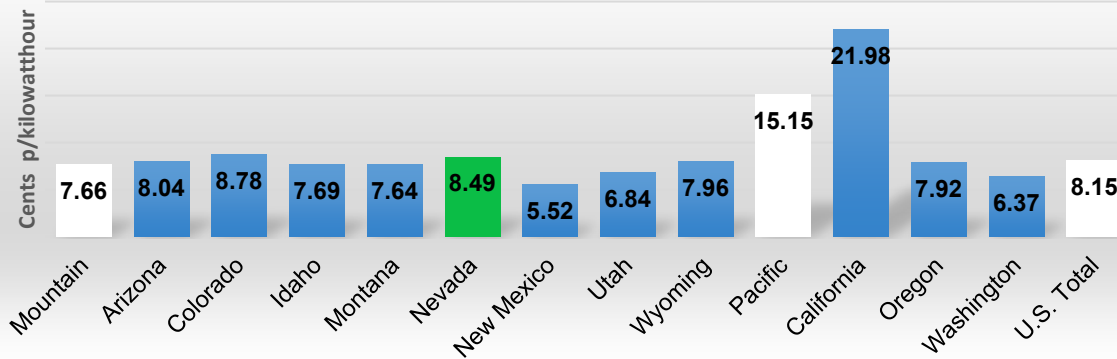
Proximity to major ports (Oakland,

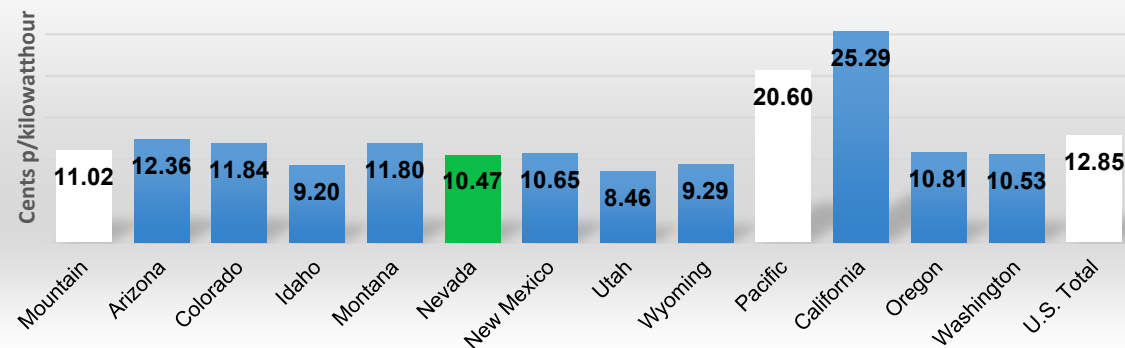
# Electric Cost Comparisons

## Thru December 2024 - Commercial



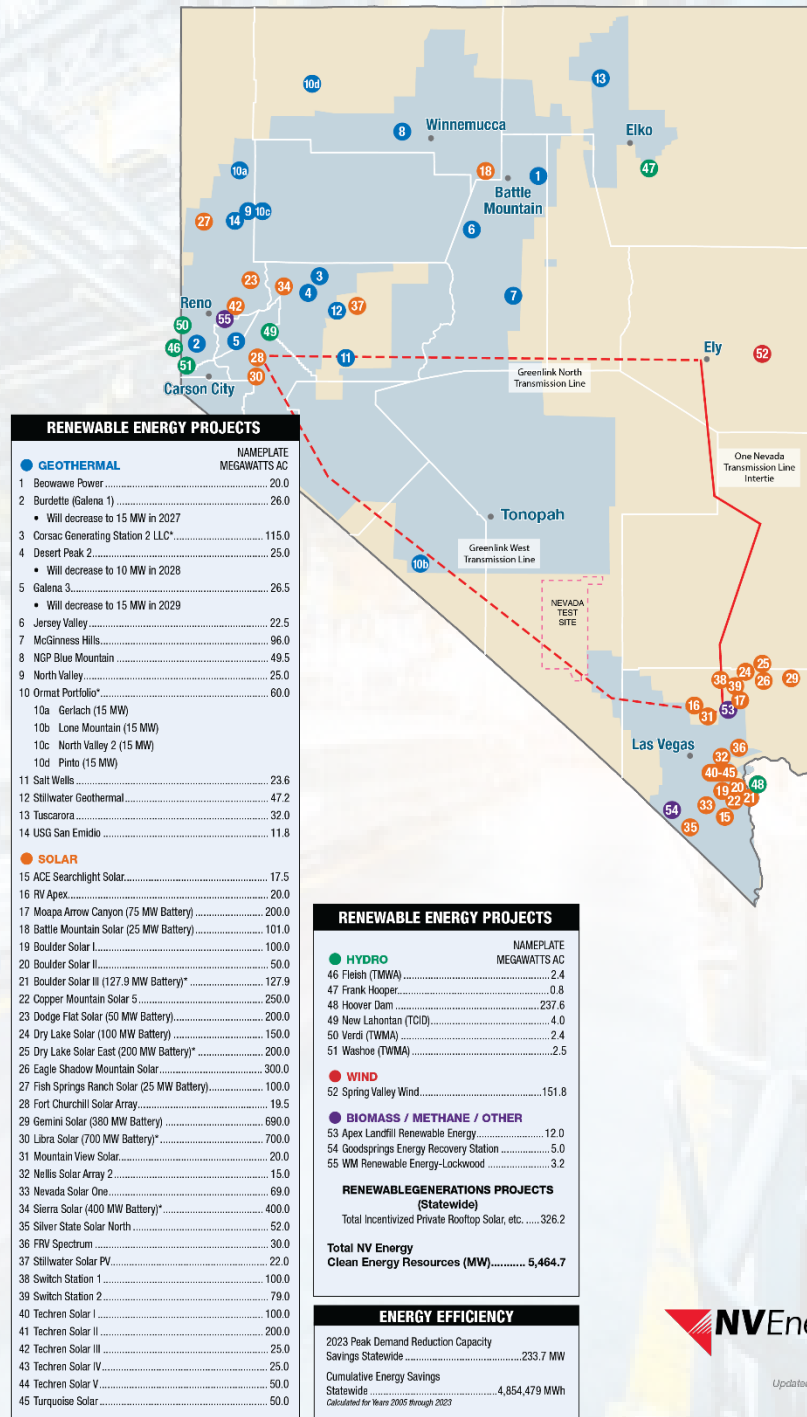
Thru December 2022, Nevada's average retail price for commercial customer's is 18.5% lower than the US average.

# Renewable Resources

- **Renewable projects:**
  - 14 Geothermal projects
  - 31 Solar projects
  - 3 Biomass/ methane/ waste heat
  - 6 Small hydro & Hoover Dam
  - 1 wind project
- **4,463 MWs of new solar with 2,083 MW of Battery Storage** under construction, in development or pending regulatory approval
