- Nevada is known for Gold, Silver and Copper production.
- Construction minerals found in abundance are Gypsum, Limestone, Sand and Gravel.
- Nevada is a significant source of Lithium, Molybdenum, Diatomite and Barite.
- Other minerals/resources found in Nevada are Petroleum, Magnesium, Salt, Silica, Dolomite, Perlite and Specialty Clays.
- Nevada produces on average:
 - 73% of the nation's gold
 - 25% of the nation's silver
 - 55% of the nation's barite

- Nevada's Esmerelda County is home to the only producing lithium mine in North America.
- Northern Nevada is home to North America's largest known Lithium (Humboldt) and Vanadium (Eureka) Deposits.








