

Schedule WCS
WIRELESS COMMUNICATION SERVICE

APPLICABLE

This Rate Schedule is applicable to low-powered single- or three-phase service for wireless technology industries that require electric service to operate radio repeaters or other wireless communication devices ("devices") that are mounted on existing Utility facilities or other facilities as approved by the Utility and such devices are un-metered. Service hereunder is limited to devices each having monthly usage of 164 kilowatt-hours or less.

TERRITORY

Entire Nevada Service Area, as specified.

RATES

The charges applicable to this rate schedule are set forth in the currently effective Statement of Rates and are incorporated herein by reference. Bundled rates can be found beginning on PUCN Sheet No. 10.

The service level for each installed device will be determined as defined in Special Condition 2 of this Schedule and according to the table below:

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. **UEC.** The Universal Energy Charge (UEC), pursuant to NAC 702.150 through 702.450, will go to fund the Nevada fund for energy assistance and conservation. Under certain circumstances, Customers will be refunded amounts paid in excess of \$25,000 per calendar quarter. The Commission will administer the collection of the UEC, certify exemptions, and administer refunds. Exemptions are generally kWh sold to:
 - a) Any governmental agency, including the State of Nevada and any political subdivision thereof, and
 - b) Any Customer using electrolytic-manufacturing processes.

Except as provided above, all kWh sold are subject to the charge. The UEC is not subject to the charges applicable under the Tax Adjustment Charge.

2. **Determination of the Monthly Fixed Charge for Electric Usage.**
The applicant shall provide the Utility information from which the Utility can determine the number of devices to be installed and the nameplate rating of each installed device from sources such as the manufacturer's equipment specifications, data sheets, etc. The Utility will place the device in the appropriate usage level based on the nameplate rating. The maximum monthly usage and Schedule GS total consumption charge will be used to calculate the monthly fixed charge for each installed device. The Utility retains the right to perform on-site inspections to verify the energy consumption of the device.

3. **Limits to Availability.** Service hereunder is available unless the Utility determines that an applicable agency having jurisdiction has an existing code, ordinance, formal policy statement or requirement that prohibits the installation of such devices. The Utility shall not have the obligation to make such determination.

4. **Wireless Communication Device Installation.**
 - A. The device shall be installed on existing Utility facilities, or other Utility-approved facilities. When the device is installed on Utility facilities in the space normally reserved for telecommunications attachment, the installation and removal of such device will be performed by the Utility or the Applicant, at the Applicant's expense. When the device is installed in the space normally reserved for supply facilities the installation and removal of the device will be performed by the Utility or by a contractor approved by the Utility. Connection to or disconnection from the Utility's electric lines of the device, including installation of any required over-current fusing as specified by the Utility, shall be performed only by an authorized employee or approved contractor of the Utility, at the Applicant's expense. Device(s) shall not be installed where location, mounting height, and/or other considerations are not acceptable to the Utility. Unless approved in writing by the Utility, all devices must be visible by the Utility.

 - B. The Utility reserves the right to operate and maintain its distribution system in an efficient manner. The Utility shall have the right to change or withdraw service to a device if changes to its distribution facilities necessitate such a change or withdrawal, such as, but not limited to pole removal or changes in pole location.

 - C. The Utility shall exercise reasonable care in providing interference-free electric service pursuant to its tariffs. The Utility shall not, by taking action pursuant to its tariffs, be liable for any loss, damage, or injury, established or alleged, which may result, or be claimed to result, from such actions.

5. **Modification of Facilities.**

- A. No modifications shall be made to the device(s) once installed unless approved by the Utility. Where the Customer requests modification of a device that is installed on the Utility's facilities, and such modification are acceptable to the Utility, the Applicant will perform all modifications of the device if the modification pertains to the telecommunications portion of the equipment and the Utility will perform the requested modifications of the supply facilities at the Applicant's expense.
- B. Modification or additions to the Utility's distribution facilities shall be in accordance with Rule 9 with no allowance given.

6. **Maintenance.** The Utility will exercise reasonable care and diligence in maintaining its facilities or Utility-owned devices attached thereto. Upon installation of the device(s), where the Utility experiences, or expects to experience, increased maintenance costs exceeding its normal maintenance expense resulting from, but not limited to vandalism, the Utility may require the Customer to pay the excess maintenance expense.

7. **Monthly Billing.** Each Customer shall be billed monthly for service. Each bill for service shall contain one monthly Basic Service Charge along with unit charges for the number of devices for which the Customer is responsible. Each device will be billed according to the rate level established for the specific device installed. The monthly bill will be the sum of the monthly Basic Service Charge and all of the flat charges associated with the number of devices installed for that Customer. Charges under Schedule MC shall apply for each callout to the device's location.
