

RULE NO. 15

TEMPORARY SERVICE

A. Establishment of Temporary Service

The Utility will, if no undue hardship to its existing Customers will result therefrom, furnish temporary service under the following conditions:

1. The Applicant will be required to pay to the Utility, in advance, the net estimated cost of installing and removing the facilities necessary for furnishing the desired service.
2. Where the duration of service is to be less than one month, the Applicant will also be required to advance a sum of money equal to the estimated bill for the service. If this advance exceeds the actual bill when known, the excess will be returned to the Applicant; if it is less than the actual bill, a bill for the deficit will be presented for payment.
3. Where the duration of service is to exceed one month, the Applicant may also be required to establish his credit in the manner prescribed in Rule No. 12, Establishment and Re-establishment of Credit.

B. Change to Permanent Status

If a Customer has operated for thirty-six (36) consecutive months the equipment for which service was originally established on a temporary basis, and Customer's operations at the end of that time have proven their permanency to the satisfaction of the Utility, the payment made pursuant to Section A-1 above will be adjusted to the terms of the mains and/or service extension rules applicable to permanent service.
