GAS SERVICE FOR COMPRESSION

APPLICABLE

Applicable for gas service to any Customer for the purpose of compressing on the Customer's premises. The compressed gas may be used in the Customer's operations, or for resale as a vehicle fuel.

TERRITORY

Service is available hereunder throughout the Company's Nevada Natural Gas Service Territory.

RATES

The charges applicable to this rate schedule are set forth in the currently effective Statement of Rates and are incorporated herein by reference. Rates can be found beginning on PUCN Sheet No. 2H.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum charge for service hereunder shall be the Basic Service Charge.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. **Service Agreement.** The Customer, prior to the establishment of service under this schedule, shall execute a service agreement for a minimum term of one year. The service agreement shall continue in effect from year to year thereafter until either party shall give the other written notice of a desire to terminate the agreement at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of any such year.
2. **Service Interruption / Curtailment.** Interruption or curtailment of gas service due to capacity constraints or conditions of force majeure on Utility's system may be imposed under this schedule pursuant to Utility's Rule 8, and General Order 18. For purposes of General Order 18, the Customer will be designated as Priority 3.

In addition, service provided under this schedule shall be subject to interruption or curtailment during peak gas use days as specified in the Service Agreement.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

- 3. Compression for Vehicle Use. Service for any end use of gas other than the compression of natural gas for vehicle use is not permitted under this schedule.
4. Metering. Service under this schedule shall be through one or more meters at the option of the Utility, provided the meters are located on the same premise.
5. UEC. The UEC as mandated by AB 661, passed by the 2001 Legislature, will go to fund the Nevada fund for energy assistance and conservation. Under certain circumstances, Customers will be refunded amounts paid in excess of \$25,000 per calendar quarter. The Commission will administer the collection of the UEC, certify exemptions, and administer refunds. Exemptions are generally Therms sold to:
a) Any governmental agency, including the State of Nevada and any political subdivision thereof, and
b) Any Customer using such natural gas solely as a source of energy to generate electricity.
Except as provided above, all Therms sold are subject to the charge. The UEC is not subject to the Tax Adjustment Charge.
