Energy-Saving Tips

- Keep your thermostat set at 78 degrees when you are home, and several degrees higher at night or when you are not home in the warmer months. For cooler months, the recommended temperature is 68 degrees.
- Close blinds and drapes during the day to keep the heat out.
- Turn off lights and appliances when not in use.
- Use your dishwasher, clothes washer and dryer before 5 p.m. or after 9 p.m. These appliances add heat to your home and make your AC work harder.
- If your AC unit is on the ground, keep the area around it clean and free of obstructions to maintain air flow to help it work more efficiently.
- Keep your freezer as full as possible. You can place containers filled with water in the empty spaces.
