



Residential Electric Vehicle Charging Station Incentive

How do I qualify for the PowerShift residential electric vehicle (EV) charging station incentive?

NV Energy customers can qualify for a PowerShift residential EV charging station incentive on a first come, first serve basis. To be eligible, your EV must have been acquired 60 calendar days before or after submitting your application. To receive the full incentive amount, you must consent to sharing charging data with NV Energy by utilizing a charging company listed as a qualified charger.

How much is the incentive?

You may qualify for the following incentive amounts based on specific qualifications:

- \$500 or 75% of total project costs, whichever is less, if you consent to share your charging data with NV Energy.
 - Your charging provider's network must be a part of NV Energy's residential network.
- \$250 or 75% of total project costs, whichever is less, if you decline to share your charging data.

Are there any associated fees to apply?

To process and review your application, a non-refundable \$35 application fee applies.









What is the process to apply for an incentive?

STEP ONE

- Select an EV charger of your choice. For a higher level of incentives, please select your charger from NV Energy's
 qualified list.
- Submit your application by navigating to the EV charging station incentives application, which can be found via NV Energy's application portal.
 - Select Residential Single-Family as the project type.
 - Your total project cost estimate should include the cost of the charger, any quoted costs by a certified C2 or C2a electrician for installation and any required electrical upgrades.
- You may purchase and install your qualifying charging station.

STEP TWO

- Upon review and approval of the application, NV Energy will issue you a reservation notice.
 - In the event that additional information is required, NV Energy will ask you for clarification prior to granting approval of your application. You can conveniently update your application via the online portal.

STEP THREE

- Once you install your charging station, you will have to complete your incentive claim package in the online portal (also known as claim form in the online portal).
 - In the event that additional information is required, NV Energy will ask for clarification prior to granting final approval of your application. You can conveniently update your application via the online portal.
- Upon final approval, NV Energy will disburse your incentive check within four to six weeks via mail.
