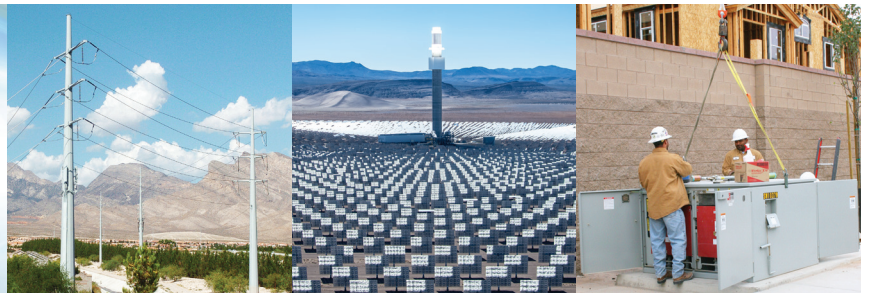


# 2016 Power Facts

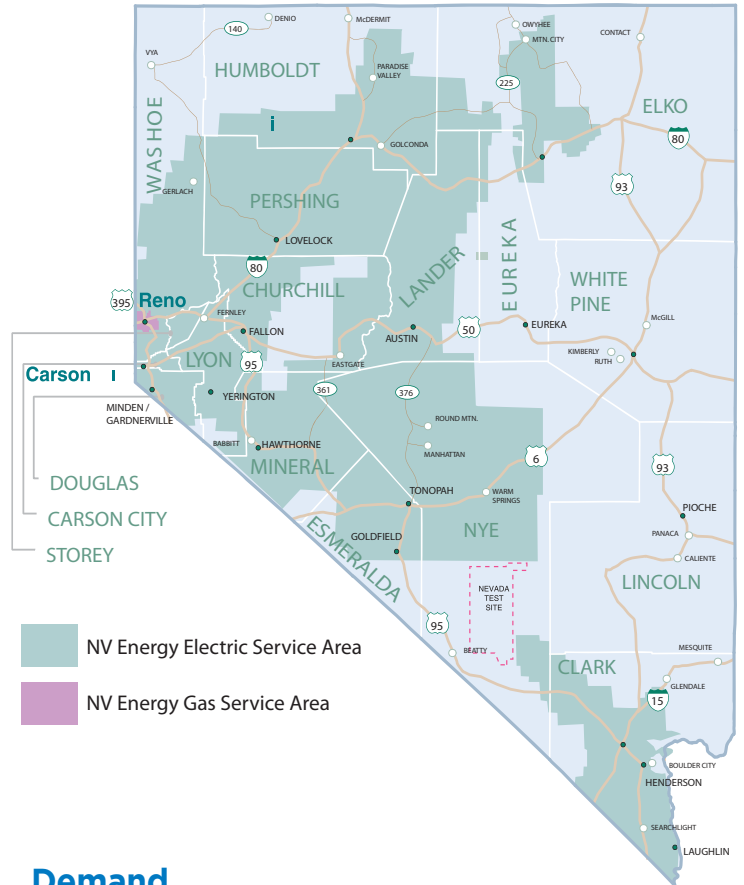

The company delivers electricity to more than 1.2 million customers and a state tourist population of more than 40 million annually. Its nearly 46,000-square-mile service territory stretches north to south from Reno to Las Vegas and Elko to Laughlin. The company also provides natural gas to more than 162,000 citizens in the Reno-Sparks area.

NV Energy is driven by its commitment to customer service. The company continues to be a leader in offering a variety of energy efficiency products and online tools that allow customers to monitor and understand their energy use, both of which can help them save energy and money on their bills. It's also a leader in securing renewable energy for its customers. In fact, much of the state's energy needs are met by 42 renewable energy plants, and NV Energy has financially supported more than 19,000 private rooftop solar installations at homes, schools, civic buildings, nonprofits and businesses.
