

ATTENTION:

Rule 9, the tariff that governs electric Line Extension projects (modifications or new connections to NV Energy's electric system), has been revised and approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN), effective August 12, 2013. This tariff dictates responsibilities and obligations of both NV Energy and Applicant (the party requesting a Line Extension) regarding the design and construction of electric Line Extensions.
