

Application for Temporary Disconnect and Reconnect (TDR)

1. TDR applications are processed by NV Energy on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. For a typical TDR the NV Energy crews will arrive around 7:00am to 8:30am to disconnect the service. **An electrician must be present on-site at time of arrival or the service will not be disconnected.** The crew will return in the afternoon to reconnect. **A final inspection by the appropriate government agency is required before crew will return to reconnect.** If you are unable to get your final inspection before the crew arrives it can take up to two (2) working days to schedule the reconnect.
3. TDR's incur a \$30.00 charge per trip the crew takes to the site. A visit to disconnect or re-connect that occurs on the same day as the request or after hours will incur a \$40.00 charge per visit. Cancelling a TDR less than 24 hours before the schedule disconnect date will incur a \$30.00 site visit charge. TDR charges will be applied to the customer's next bill.
4. Please complete this application in full. NV Energy will not process an incomplete application. Submit the completed application to the NV Energy New Development Center at 7155 Lindell Road, Las Vegas, NV 89118. You may also submit via fax or e-mail listed at the top of this page.
5. If the customer electric panel is being upgraded, existing NV Energy facilities may not be adequate to accommodate your request. If this is the case an NV Energy representative request you fill out a project information sheet and submit it back to the New Development Center.
6. If the panel requires CT's, please complete a service entrance equipment information form, attach meter and CT equipment technical documents. Your assigned coordinator can help you with this process.
7. A description of all the work being done by the customer must be included with this TDR application. If upon arrival at the site, the NV Energy crew determines the conditions differ from those described in the TDR application, the work will not be completed, and you will need to resubmit a new TDR application.
