Definitions:

- Pole Grubbing:** The removal of trees, shrubs, stumps, roots, cheatgrass, sagebrush, and other fine fuels in proximity to a pole or other susceptible assets to create a combustible-free space.
- Right of Way Clearing:** The removal of trees, shrubs, stumps, roots, cheatgrass, sagebrush, and other fine fuels off the land underneath a distribution or transmission line
- Herbicide Application:** The application of approved liquid or granular herbicide to deter the regrowth of vegetation.
- Targeted Grazing:** The use of goats, sheep, and/ or a Salt Lick Program to remove vegetation from around and under the infrastructure
