- Single-family or multifamily homes up to four units per foundation
- Home must achieve ENERGY STAR® certification
- Built 10% above code or better*

SINGLE-FAMILY AND MULTIFAMILY NEW CONSTRUCTION

Rebates increase by \$20 per 1% improvement

Central Air Conditioners (CAC) or Air Source Heat Pumps

- 10%–14% Improvement: **\$200–\$280**
- 15%–19% Improvement: **\$300–\$380**
- 20%–24% Improvement: **\$400–\$480**
- 25% Improvement: **\$500**
