UNDERSTANDING YOUR BILL

3. **Next Meter Read Date**

6. **KWHD (Kilowatt-Hours Delivered):** This is the energy delivered to your home from the power grid.
7. **KWHR (Kilowatt-Hours Received):** This is the excess energy generated by your renewable system that is pushed back to the power grid. The amount of energy you push back into the power grid will be credited to you as an Excess Energy Credit if you've produced more energy than needed from the grid.
8. **KWHA (Kilowatt-Hours Accumulated):** This service category applies to Net Metering customers prior to January 1, 2016. It is the accumulated net excess generation from a customer's renewable energy system. Any existing accumulated credit banked prior to January 1, 2016, will continue to be applied until the balance is depleted. It will appear on your bill until customers with accumulated KWHA credits are depleted. This is not a channel on your meter and is only used to manage the banked kilowatt hours each month. The total accumulated or banked kilowatts will be listed under Meter Readings, see the Current amount.

Customer who have Net Meters set after January 1, 2016, will see a zero on their statement since they will receive a monetary credit for all Kilowatt-Hours Received (KWHR).

9. **KWHN (Kilowatt-Hours Net):** This line displays your billable Kilowatt-Hours and is calculated in the following manner:
KWHD - KWHA = KWHN.
10. **Electric Consumption:** This is the amount of electricity you are charged for.
11. **Excess Energy Credit:** This credit only applies to Customers who are users of a net metering system as defined by NRS 704.771. The Excess Energy Credit Rate provides compensation for any kilowatt-hour of energy not consumed by the Customer that is fed back onto the Utility's system by the Customer's net metering system.

Bill items 13-15 and 18 are charges for the sustainable energy programs referred to as Temporary Green Power Financing, Renewable Energy Program, Energy Efficiency Charge and Universal Energy Charge. The charges are assessed based on the total Kilowatt-hours delivered to your home. If there is no energy delivered to your home during the billing period, customers pay the basic service charge and local government fee to retain electric service.
